Candida normally lives in the gastrointestinal tract and on skin without causing any problems, but it can enter the bloodstream during a hospital stay and cause infection. Fungal lung infections require medications that are usually prescribed and monitored by a lung specialist. If there is an underlying cause for a weakened immune system (like HIV, tuberculosis or immunosuppressant medications) then these will need to be looked at.
