Nonetheless, within this structure, imitation (of Paul) is essential to salvation. However, as Castelli notes, Paul has a rather serious identity problem: his desire, as part of his rhetoric of mimesis, to equate himself (as mimic/copy) to Christ (as model/origin). Paul is both model and mimic, and thus his identity is "split" (schizophrenic?).
