It is under the jurisdiction of the Diocese of Leeds (until 1836 it was part of the Diocese of Chester, and from 1836 until 2014 in the Diocese of Ripon). It is divided into seven rural deaneries: Bowland, Ewecross, Harrogate, Richmond, Ripon, Skipton, and Wensley.
